Rules & Regulations Saturday, November 22nd at 5pm

- Business vehicles pulling non-profit groups or organizations must cover up their business name/logo in order to avoid paying the \$75 Business entry fee. ALL businesses displaying logos and/or business name must pay \$75 entry fee.
- Business entry fee is \$75 per unit, float, or vehicle if received by November 15th, 2025. Multiple vehicles must each pay a \$75 entry fee. Entries received November 16-19 will be charged a Late Entry Fee of \$150 per vehicle.
- Non-profit groups and individuals must pay a \$10 registration fee per vehicle if received by November 15th, 2025. Entries for non-profit groups and individuals received November 16-19 will be charged a Late Entry Fee of \$25 per vehicle.
- Drivers must have a valid driver's license to operate a motorized vehicle.
- Entry fees must be paid prior to parade day. Please include payment with application. Applications must be received on or before November 19th, for entry into parade. Entries received after November 19th may not be allowed to participate in the parade.
- The parade marshals will control the conduct and traffic flow of the parade. Participants will obey the directions of the marshals as they relate to the parade. Failure to do so will cause the offending individual or unit to be removed from the parade and could limit participation in future parades. Individuals and organizations in the parade are expected to behave courteously and with safety in mind at all times during the formation, execution and dismissal of the parade.
- Sponsor identification on floats must be on both sides. Marching units and multi-vehicle units must be proceeded by an identifying banner or sign.
- Units may contain no element higher than 13 feet to provide clearance of overhead wires and lights.
- All participants starting the parade from Veteran's Park must assemble there one hour prior to parade time (4pm at the latest). Parade time is 5pm. All tractor-trailers must be draped on BOTH sides.
- Carpooling is highly recommended for large groups, and the groups should meet somewhere other than Veterans Park and Lebanon Street. If parents do need to drop off children at Veterans Park, parents should park at the very back of the Veterans Park, and the parent is responsible for finding their child's float. Please do not ask the parade marshals or the Rescue Squad officials to track down floats.
- Late units and late participants may not be allowed to participate.
- Groups walking in the parade have the option to assemble on the corner of North Main and Taylor streets by 4pm. (You may walk all the way from Veterans' Park if you prefer.)
- Animals walking in parade must have a human with them who will promptly clean up all messes.
- In the event of inclement weather, the parade will proceed unless deemed unsafe to do so. For more information regarding a possible parade cancellation, listen to WPAQ & WSYD.
- No candy is to be thrown from a vehicle! Please have designated people with your group to walk beside your vehicle to distribute the candy.
- Please do not have participants dressed as Santa Claus on your float. Santa Claus will be at the end of the parade and we do not want to cause confusion for the kids.

Please keep this copy of these rules in your vehicle, displayed on your dash, as you enter the park on parade day.
